RESOLVE, Authorizing the Bureau of Health to Conduct a Time-Trend Study of Leukemia Incidence in Maine.

5 Authorization of Study. Resolved: That the 6 Bureau of Health shall conduct a time-trend study of 7 the incidence of leukemia in the State. The bureau 8 shall enlist the aid of health professionals, scientists and other qualified individuals. bureau shall report its findings to the First Regular The

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Session of the 114th Legislature by January 1, 1989.

STATEMENT OF FACT

3 Since the early 1970's, Maine's leukemia rate has 4 risen. Leukemia is considered an early warning of 5 other cancers and illnesses. Before the 1970's, Maine 6 had the lowest leukemia rate in the 48 contiguous 7 states. A private study has shown that the coastal 8 rate has more than doubled and is 42% above the 9 national average.

10 This authorization will allow the Bureau of Health 11 to increase its knowledge of factors influencing the 12 state of the public health.

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
