The South Berwick Sewer District has a present debt limit of \$500,000 which was enacted in 1964. present treatment system is not in compliance with the 6 7 United States Clean Water Act, Public Law 92-500, 8 requiring best practical treatment. The district will be required to spend money for upgrading its facility 9 to secondary treatment levels within the next several 10 This will require predominantly local funding 11 through bond issues with repayment through user fees, 12 rents and tolls. Some state or federal grant and loan 13 14 money may also be available under various programs.

This bill will allow local funding to provide for the district's sewage treatment system to meet state and federal regulations.
