7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1777, L.D. 2430,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Fund and Implement a Collective
9 Bargaining Agreement with Certain Vocational-Technical
10 Institute System Employees Represented by the Maine
11 Teachers Association."

12 Amend the bill by striking out everything after
13 the enacting clause and before the emergency clause
14 and inserting in its place the following:

15 'PART A

16 Sec. 1. Cost to the General Fund. There is
17 appropriated in Part B funding sufficient when
18 combined with other available funds to cover the costs
19 to the General Fund in the amount of \$474,193 for the
20 fiscal year ending June 30, 1988, and the amount of
21 \$967,573 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1989, to
22 implement the economic terms of the collective
23 bargaining agreements agreed to by the Maine
24 Vocational-Technical Institute System and the Maine
25 Teachers Association for the vocational-technical
26 institute faculty and administration bargaining units.

27 Sec. 2. Adjustment of salary schedule for fiscal
28 year 1987-88. Effective at the beginning of the pay
29 week commencing closest to July 1, 1987, the salary
30 schedule for employees in the vocational-technical

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1 institute faculty and administrative bargaining units
2 shall be adjusted by 4%, consistent with the terms of
3 the collective bargaining agreements.

4 Sec. 3. Adjustment of salary schedule for fiscal
5 year 1988-89. Effective at the beginning of the pay
6 week commencing closest to July 1, 1988, the salary
7 schedule for employees in the vocational-technical
8 institute faculty and administrative bargaining units
9 shall be adjusted by 4%, consistent with the terms of
10 the collective bargaining agreements.

11 Sec. 4. New employees' similar and equitable
12 treatment. Employees in classifications included in
13 the vocational-technical institute faculty and
14 administrative bargaining units, but who are excluded
15 from collective bargaining pursuant to the Maine
16 Revised Statutes, Title 26, section 1022, subsection
17 11, paragraph D, shall be given similar and equitable
18 treatment on a pro rata basis to that given employees
19 covered by the collective bargaining agreements.

21 Appropriation. The following funds are
22 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
23 purposes of this Act.
