AN ACT to Fund and Implement a Collective					
Bargaining Agreement with Certain					
Vocational-Technical Institute System					
Employees Represented by the Maine Teachers					
Association.					

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of the Maine Vocational-Technical Institute System collective bargaining agreements will become due and payable immediately; and

Whereas, it is the responsibility of the Legislature to act upon those portions of tentative bargaining agreements negotiated by the Executive Department on behalf of the Maine Vocational-Technical Institute System employees which require legislative action; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these 11 12 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the 13 Constitution of Maine and require the following 14 legislation as immediately necessary for 15 preservation of the public peace, health and safety; 16 now, therefore,

17 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 18 follows:

19 PART A

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Sec. 1. Cost to the General Fund. There appropriated in Part B funding sufficient combined with other available funds to cover the costs to the General Fund in the amount of \$428,183 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1988 and the amount of \$843,204 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1989, to implement the economic terms of the collective the Maine bargaining agreements agreed to by Vocational-Technical Institute System and the Teachers Association for the Vocational-Technical Institute Faculty Bargaining Unit.

Sec. 2. Adjustment of salary schedule for fiscal year 1987-88. Effective at the beginning of the pay week commencing closest to July 1, 1987, the salary schedule for employees in the Vocational-Technical Institute Faculty Unit shall be adjusted by 4%, consistent with the terms of the collective bargaining agreement.

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Part A identifies and implements the cost items of the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Maine Vocational-Technical Institute System and

the Maine Vocational-Technical Institute System and the Maine Teachers Association for the Vocational-Technical Institute Faculty Unit.

7 Section 1 reflects the costs from the General Fund 8 to fund the bargaining agreements.

9 Section 2 provides for the adjustment of salary 10 schedules effective July 1, 1987, consistent with the 11 terms of the collective bargaining agreement.

Section 3 provides for the adjustment of salary schedules effective July 1, 1988, consistent with the terms of the collective bargaining agreement.

Section 4 provides for similar and equitable treatment of probationary and other employees in classifications in the Vocational-Technical Institute Faculty Unit.

19 Part B provides for appropriations from the 20 General Fund for Part A.

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
