Amend the bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§12102." in subsection 3 in the 6th line
(page 3, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the
underlined word "scholarship" the following: 'or'

Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking
out all of that part designated "§12104."

Further amend the bill by striking out all of
section 2 and section 3.

Further amend the bill by striking out all of
section 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds
are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out
the purposes of this Act.
