7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1785, L.D. 2446, 8 "RESOLVE, to Establish The Special Commission on 9 Boating."

10 Amend the resolve by inserting after the title the 11 following:

12 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves 13 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 14 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; 15 and

16 Whereas, the improper operation of boating 17 equipment creates a hazard threatening the health and 18 safety of residents and visitors to this State; and

19 Whereas, an increasing number of complaints about 20 the operation of jet-skis and other watercraft have 21 been received; and

22 Whereas, increases in the amount of lakeside 23 construction and increases in the number of summer 24 visitors to Maine will only lead to more conflicts 25 between recreational users of the State's waters 26 unless boating safety issues are addressed; and

27 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these 28 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the 29 Constitution of Maine and require the following 30 legislation as immediately necessary for the

1 preservation of the public peace, health and safety; 2 now, therefore, be it'

3 Further amend the resolve by striking out all of 4 the 2nd resolve paragraph and inserting in its place 5 the following:

6 'Compensation. Resolved: All nonagency members 7 of the commission shall receive reimbursement for 8 expenses upon application to the Legislative Council; 9 and be it further'

10 Further amend the resolve by striking out all of 11 the last resolve paragraph and inserting in its place 12 the following:

13 'Appropriation. Resolved: That the following 14 funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry 15 out the purposes of this resolve.

25 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency 26 cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect 27 when approved.'

## 28 STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment removes the per diem for legislative members of the commission, adds a public hearing and decreases the original provision for expenses. An

emergency preamble and emergency clause are added to allow the commission to hold public hearings during the summer when boating safety issues are of most concern. For the same reason the appropriation is changed to the current fiscal year.
