STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

RESOLVE, Regarding the Study of Low-Level 2 Radioactive Waste in the Town of 3 Greenbush. 5 State Geologist to conduct study. Resolved: That the State Geologist, with the cooperation of the 6 7 Department of Environmental Protection, shall conduct 8 study of the former University of Maine System 9 low-level radioactive disposal waste site Department of Conservation land in the Town of 10

- 1 Greenbush. The study shall include the following 2 elements:
- 3 assessment of of low-level ra the impact of the 4 disposal of low-level radioactive waste and other 5 materials at the site hazardous on around quality;
 - An evaluation of the effectiveness of past remedial actions taken at the site;
- 9 3. An evaluation of the health and environmental 10 risks of removing the radioactive waste materials and 11 other hazardous materials to an approved disposal site;

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further

- 12 4. The preparation of a permanent closure plan 13 for the site which meets all federal and state 14 requirements for the closure of low-level radioactive 15 waste disposal sites; and
- 16 5. The preparation of a 5-year monitoring program 17 to assess impacts on ground water quality; and be it 18 further
- 19 Report. Resolved: That the State Geologist 20 shall issue a report on the findings to the joint 21 standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over natural resources, the Governor, the 22 23 chancellor of the University of Maine System and 24 Greenbush municipal officers by January 15, 1989; and 25 be it further
- 26 Future fiscal responsibility. Resolved: That the 27 University of Maine System shall reimburse the Maine Geological Survey for all costs associated with the conduct of this study and that the university shall 28 29 30 incorporate the funds necessary to implement 31 recommended actions in its budget proposal to 32 Legislature for fiscal year 1990 and beyond; and be it
- 34 Appropriation. Resolved: That the following 35 funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry 36 out the purposes of this resolve.
