1 AN ACT to Make Supplemental Allocations to the
2 Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for
3 the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1988, and
4 June 30, 1989.
5

6 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the
7 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days
8 after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

9 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident

1 to the operation of the Department of Inland Fisheries
2 and Wildlife will become due and payable immediately;
3 and

4 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
5 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the
6 Constitution of Maine and require the following
7 legislation as immediately necessary for the
8 preservation of the public peace, health and safety;
9 now, therefore,

10 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
11 follows:

12 Supplemental allocation of the Department of
13 Inland Fisheries and Wildlife funds. Income to the
14 Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for the
15 fiscal years ending June 30, 1988, and June 30, 1989,
16 shall be segregated, apportioned and disbursed as
17 designated in the following schedule:

18 1987-88 1988-89

19 INLAND FISHERIES AND
20 WILDLIFE, DEPARTMENT OF

21 Fisheries and Hatcheries
22 Operations

23 Capital Expenditures \$120,000 \$120,000

24 Allocates funds which
25 have been transferred
26 from the Department of
27 Conservation, Bureau
28 of Parks and
29 Recreation, Boating
30 Facilities Fund, for
31 funding boat access,
32 acquisition, and
33 maintenance projects.
34 Seventy-five percent
35 of these amounts will
36 be reimbursed by the

1 Federal Sport Fish
2 Restoration money.

3 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
4 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when
5 approved.

6 STATEMENT OF FACT

7 The purpose of this bill is to make supplemental
8 allocations to the Department of Inland Fisheries and
9 Wildlife for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1988,
10 and June 30, 1989.
