SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1797, L.D. 2461, Bill, "AN ACT to Prohibit the Sale of Polystyrene Foam Products Containing Chlorofluorocarbons."

Amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "§1603." by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in its place the following:


'1. Prohibition. After January 1, 1989, no person may sell or offer to sell in this State any product composed in whole or in part of polystyrene foam if the foam is manufactured with any fully halogenated chlorofluorocarbon found by the United States Environmental Protection Agency to significantly contribute to the destruction of stratospheric ozone.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the wording of subsection 1 dealing with prohibitions.
