COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1797, L.D. 2461,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Prohibit the Sale of Polystyrene Foam  
Products Containing Chlorofluorocarbons."

Amend the bill in the title in the 3rd line (page  
1, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting after the  
word "Containing" the following: 'or Made with  
Certain'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of  
section 3 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 3. 38 MRSa §1603 is enacted to read:

§1603. Polystyrene foam products

1. Prohibition. After January 1, 1989, no person  
may sell or offer to sell in this State any product  
composed in whole or in part of polystyrene foam if  
the foam is manufactured with any chlorofluorocarbon  
compound found by the United States Environmental  
Protection Agency to contribute to the destruction of  
stratospheric ozone.

2. Compliance. All distributors engaged in the  
sale or distribution of polystyrene foam products in  
Maine which contain chlorofluorocarbons shall certify  
to the Department of Environmental Protection by  
January 31, 1989, their compliance with subsection 1.
