After January 1, 1989, no person may sell or offer to sell in this State any product composed in whole or in part of thermoformed extruded polystyrene foam sheets if the foam is manufactured using any fully halogenated chlorofluorocarbon found by the United States Environmental Protection Agency to be an ozone-depleting chemical.

21 It is anticipated that all costs associated with 22 this bill would be absorbed by the Department of 23 Environmental Protection utilizing existing resources.'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment prohibits the sale of polystyrene foam sheet products which utilize certain forms of the chlorofluorocarbon blowing agents that have been found to lead to destruction of the stratospheric ozone layer. Because the plastics industry has developed alternatives to these compounds, the amendment allows for sale of polystyrene foam products which are manufactured without use of the destructive forms of chlorofluorocarbon gas. It also allows for the sale of products composed of polystyrene foam boards, which

1 are used in insulation, until a substitute for the 2 blowing agent is approved and available.

3 The amendment also requires distributors who do 4 business in Maine to document their compliance or 5 scheduled compliance with this section.

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
