8 to H.P. 1799, L.D. 2463, Bill, "AN ACT to Fund a
9 Supplemental Highway Program and to Establish a
10 Program to Fund the Construction of Extraordinary
11 Bridges."

12 Amend the amendment by inserting after section 2
13 th following:

14 'Sec. 3. 23 MRSA §1804, as enacted by PL 1981,
15 c. 492, Pt. C, §26, is amended to read:

16 §1804. Municipal requirements

17 To be eligible to receive funds from the Local
18 Road Assistance Program, each municipality shall,
19 prior to August 1st each year, certify in a manner
20 acceptable to the department that the funds will be
21 used only for the maintenance or improvement of public
22 roads. Effective July 1, 1989, municipalities shall
23 accept these funds provided by the Legislature only
24 upon affirmative vote of their legislative bodies.
25 Those municipalities holding a town meeting shall
26 include an article on the warrant which shall read as
27 follows: "Shall the town accept Local Road Assistance
28 Program funds of \$ as provided by the Maine
29 Legislature?" Those funds not accepted by any
30 municipality shall remain in the Highway Fund.'
