16	§1804. Municipal requirements
17 18 19 20 21	To be eligible to receive funds from the Local Road Assistance Program, each municipality shall, prior to August 1st each year, certify in a manner acceptable to the department that the funds will be used only for the maintenance or improvement of public roads. Effective July 1, 1989, municipalities shall
23 24	accept these funds provided by the Legislature only upon affirmative vote of their legislative bodies.
25 26	Those municipalities holding a town meeting shall include an article on the warrant which shall read as
27 28	follows: "Shall the town vote to accept Local Road
29	Assistance Program funds as provided by the Maine State Legislature?" The town shall indicate an
30	estimate of the amount to be received on the warrant,
31 32	but it does not have to be part of the article. Those funds not accepted by any municipality shall remain in
33	the Highway Fund.
