Sec. 4. Aroostook County. The amount
authorized for Aroostook County includes an amount to
cover the purchase of a trail groomer and the building
of a shed located in the Township of Sinclair which
will be used for maintaining snowmobile trails and
other county purposes. This equipment and shed is
held in trust for the unorganized territory of
Aroostook County. The maintenance of this equipment
and shed shall be financed solely from snowmobile
grant reimbursements. The trail groomer and shed
shall may be leased to the Sinclair Township
Committee or provided for their use with the provision
that the excess of the grant, after maintenance, will
reimburse the unorganized territory county fund for
the purchase of the properties groomer. After

1 payment of the total price, the county commissioners
2 shall transfer ownership of the groomer to the
3 Sinclair Township Committee. The county commissioners
4 are authorized to sell the trail groomer and shed
5 to the Sinclair Township Committee for the remaining
6 balance of the price at any time. At no time may
7 the county have any liability resulting from use of
8 ownership of the property. The Sinclair Township
9 Committee county shall provide and maintain liability
10 insurance for the property. The trail groomer may not
11 be operated if insurance has not been procured.

12 Any payments made to associations, clubs or other
13 organizations from funds obtained under the Maine
14 Revised Statutes, Title 36, chapter 115, shall be made
15 in quarterly installments.'

16 Further amend the amendment in the first line
17 after the title (page 1, line 10 in amendment) by
18 striking out the following: "Amend the bill" and
19 inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend
20 the bill'

21 Further amend the amendment by inserting at the
22 end the following:

23 'Further amend the bill by renumbering the
24 sections to read consecutively.'
