1 **AN ACT Pertaining To Free Hunting Licenses For**
2 **Residents Over 70 Years Of Age Who Have Had**
3 **Military Service.**

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§1, ¶A is enacted to read:

8 A. Any resident who is entitled to a

1 complimentary license under this subsection and
2 who can show proof of an honorable discharge from
3 military service shall not be required to take any
4 type of hunter safety course as a prerequisite for
5 the complimentary license.

6 STATEMENT OF FACT

7 This bill exempts Maine residents over 70 years of
8 age with military service from taking any type of
9 hunter safety test in order to receive a complimentary
10 license.
