AN ACT to Require Audit Review

of the Bureau of Capitol Security

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

in 1989.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §507, sub-§1, ¶B, as repealed and replaced by PL 1979, c. 338, §2, is amended to
