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1 AN ACT to Require Audit Review  
2 of the Bureau of Capitol Security  
3 in 1989.  
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5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
6 follows:

7 Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §507, sub-§1, ¶B, as repealed  
8 and replaced by PL 1979, c. 338, §2, is amended to  
9 read:

1 B. The evaluations and analyses of the  
2 justification reports for the programs of the  
3 following Group A-2 departments shall be reviewed  
4 by the Legislature no later than June 30, 1981:

5 (1) Department of Transportation;

6 (2) Department of Public Safety, except for  
7 the Bureau of Capitol Security; and

8 (3) Department of the Secretary of State.

9 Sec. 2. 3 MRSA §507, sub-§9, ¶B, as repealed  
10 and replaced by PL 1987, c. 395, Pt. A, §6, is amended  
11 to read:

12 B. The evaluations and analyses of the  
13 justification reports for the programs of the  
14 following Group F-2 departments shall be reviewed  
15 by the Legislature no later than June 30, 1990:

16 (1) Department of Finance;

17 (2) (Office of) Treasurer of State;

18 (3) Department of Audit;

19 (4) Department of Administration, except for  
20 the Bureau of Human Resources, Bureau of  
21 Employee Relations and Bureau of Public  
22 Improvements; and

23 (5) Department of the Attorney  
24 General; and

25 (6) Department of Public Safety, but limited  
26 to the Bureau of Capitol Security.

27 STATEMENT OF FACT

28 This bill requires the joint standing committee of  
29 the Legislature having jurisdiction over audit and  
30 program review to review the Bureau of Capitol  
31 Security in 1989 rather than 1990 as provided in  
32 current law.

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
