	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Outless Bit Bull

§3954. Keeping of pit bull dog prohibited

It is unlawful to keep, harbor, own or in any way

ì possess a pit bull dog. Exception. Any pit bull dog registered with municipality on the date of publication of this Ž 3 4 section may be kept subject to the standards 5 requirements set forth in section 3955. 6 Pit bull dog. "Pit bull dog" is defined to 7 mean: 8 The bull terrier breed of dog: ģ The Staffordshire bull terrier breed of dog; 10 The American pit bull terrier breed of dog; 11 D. The American Staffordshire terrier breed of 12 dog; 13 E. Dogs of mixed breeds or of breeds other than 14 those listed in this subsection, which breeds or mixed breeds are known as pit bulls, pit bull dogs or pit bull terriers; and 15 16 Any dog which has the appearance 17 characteristics of being predominently of 18 bull terrier, Staffordshire 19 breeds of 20 terrier, American pit bull terrier, American Staffordshire terrier; any other breed commonly known as pit bulls, pit bull dogs or pit bull ŽÎ. 22 terriers; or a combination of any of these breeds. 23 24 \$3955. Keeping of registered pit bulls 25 Section 3954 is not applicable to owners, keepers or harborers of pit bull dogs registered on the effective date of this section. The keeping of those dogs shall be subject to the following standards. 26 27 28 29 1. Leash and muzzle. No person may permit a registered pit bull dog to go outside its kennel or 30. 31 pen unless the dog is securely leashed with a leash no longer than 4 feet in length. No person may permit a pit bull dog to be kept on a chain, rope or other type of leash outside its kennel or pen unless a person is ĴŽ

in physical control of the leash. These dogs may not be leashed to inamimate objects such as trees, posts or buildings. In addition, all pit bull dogs on a leash outside the animal's kennel must be muzzled by a muzzling device sufficient to prevent the dog from biting persons or other animals.

- 2. Confinement. All registered pit bull dogs shall be securely confined indoors or in a securely enclosed and locked pen or kennel, except when leashed and muzzled as provided in subsection 1. The pen, kennel or structure must have secure sides and a secure top attached to the sides. All structures used to confine registered pit bull dogs must be locked with a key or combination lock when the animals are within the structure. The structure must have a secure bottom or floor attached to the sides of the pen or the sides of the pen must be embedded in the ground no less than 2 feet. The structures must be adequately lighted and ventilated and kept in a clean and sanitary condition.
- 3. Confinement indoors. No pit bull dog may be kept on a porch, patio or in any part of a house or structure that would allow the dog to exit the building on its own volition. In addition, no such animal may be kept in a house or structure when the windows are open or when screen windows or screen doors are the only obstacle preventing the dog from exiting the structure.
- 4. Signs. All owners, keepers or harborers of registered pit bull dogs shall within 10 days of the effective date of this section display in a prominent place on their premises a sign easily readable by the public using the words "Beware of Dog." In addition, a similar sign is required to be posted on the kennel or pen of the animal.
  - 5. Insurance. All owners, keepers or harborers of registered pit bull dogs must, within 10 days of the effective date of this section, provide proof to the Animal Welfare Board of public liability insurance in a single incident amount of \$50,000 for bodily injury to or death of any person or persons or for

- damage to property owned by any persons which may result from the ownership, keeping or maintenance of the animal. The insurance policy shall provide that no cancellation of the policy will be made unless 10 days written notice is first given to the Animal Welfare Board.
- 6. Identification photographs. All owners, keepers or harborers of registered pit bull dogs must, within 10 days of the effective date of this section, provide 2 color photographs to the clerk of the municipality where the dog is registered of the registered animal in different poses clearly showing the color and approximate size of the animal.
  - 7. Reporting requirements. All owners, keepers or harborers of registered pit bull dogs must, within 10 days of the incident, report the following information in writing to the clerk of the municipality where the dog is registered as required:

- A. The removal from the municipality or death of a registered pit bull dog;
- 21 B. The birth of offspring of a registered pit 22 bull dog; and
- 23 <u>C. The new address of a registered pit bull dog</u> 24 <u>owner should the owner move within the State.</u>
  - 8. Sale or transfer of ownership prohibited. No person may sell, barter or in any other way dispose of a pit bull dog to any person unless the recipient person resides permanently in the same household and on the same premises as the registered owner of the dog, except that the registered owner of a pit bull dog may sell or otherwise dispose of a registered dog or the offspring of the dog to persons who do not reside within the State.
- 9. Animals born of registered dogs. All offspring born of pit bull dogs registered within the municipality must be removed from the municipality within 6 weeks of the birth of the animal.

Any dog found to be the subject of a violation of this section shall be subject to immediate seizure and impoundment. Failure to comply will result in the revocation of the licent of the animal resulting in the immediate removal of the animal.	ns he be re
