COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1814, L.D. 2482,  
"RESOLVE, Reimbursing Certain Municipalities on  
Account of Taxes Lost Due to Lands being Classified  
under the Maine Tree Growth Tax Law."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after  
the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves  
of the Legislature do not become effective until 90  
days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;  
and

Whereas, certain municipalities have been  
reimbursed 75% of the tax loss pursuant to the Maine  
Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 578, and there  
remains money due these municipalities; and

Whereas, certain municipalities currently need the  
remaining reimbursement funds due to the taxes lost;  
and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these  
facts create an emergency within the meaning of the  
Constitution of Maine and require the following  
legislation as immediately necessary for the  
preservation of the public peace, health and safety;  
now, therefore, be it
