STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

Resolve, to Ensure Payment of Attorney Fees Incurred by Maine State Police Trooper Michael T. Edes.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

9 Whereas, Michael T. Edes, a Maine State Trooper, 10 was indicted by the Somerset Grand Jury for the

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1 criminal offense of Class D assault by indictment on 2 November 5, 1987; and

3 Whereas, the alleged offense arose out of and in 4 the course of Michael Edes' employment by the State 5 while he was investigating and arresting a suspect for 6 operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of 7 intoxicating liquor; and

8 Whereas, Michael T. Edes was suspended without pay 9 by his department on the date of the indictment and, 10 at his own expense, hired legal counsel to fully 11 contest the allegations contained in the indictment 12 and was granted a "not guilty" verdict; and

Whereas, by successfully conducting a vigorous defense against a charge determined to be unfounded, Michael Edes has conferred a benefit upon the people of the State by restoring to them his services as a Maine State Trooper and by shielding the State from exposure to a civil action threatened to be brought by the alleged victim of the unfounded charge; and

20 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these 21 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the 22 and require the following Constitution of Maine 23 legislation immediately necessary for the as preservation of the public peace, health and safety; 24 25 now, therefore, be it

26 Compensation authorized. Resolved: That the 27 Governor is authorized and directed, upon receipt of 28 the necessary releases, to pay \$10,173 from 29 appropriate funds to Michael T. Edes, of Jackman, as compensation for attorney's fees which he incurred as a result of having been prosecuted by the State and 30 31 .32 ultimately acquitted. The payment authorized by this 33 resolve shall be in full satisfaction of all claims by Michael T. Edes against the State and its employees 34 for damages resulting from this incident. 35

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36 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency 37 cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect 38 when approved.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this resolve is reflected in the emergency preamble.

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
