9 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to change the funding of the Strategic Training for Accelerated Reemployment Program, also known as the STAR program, if from a new payroll tax on employers to the General Fund.

At the same time, this removes the circuit-breaker provision that would have terminated the program as 15 16 soon as unemployment increased by enough to trigger a change in the unemployment tax schedule. By removing this provision, the amendment assures that the STAR program will continue to be available for unemployed 17 18 19 20 Without the 21 workers at their greatest time of need. 22 amendment, the program would terminate STAR 23 unemployment increases.

The amendment also makes clear that job opportunities may exist in new businesses as well as stable and expanding existing businesses.

Finally, the amendment requires any reports on the STAR program to include information on the sizes and types of businesses for which individuals are given customized and on-the-job training.
