STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

RESOLVE, for Laying of the County Taxes and Authorizing Expenditures of Franklin County for the Year 1988.

Whereas, Acts and resolves 5 Emergency preamble. of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; 6 8 and

9 Whereas, Franklin County has certain expenses and 10 liabilities which must be met as they become due; and

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1 Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the 2 year 1988 hereinafter mentioned be immediately 3 assessed in order to provide the required revenue for 4 the county; and

5 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these 6 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the 7 Constitution of Maine and require the following 8 legislation as immediately necessary for the 9 preservation of the public peace, health and safety; 10 now, therefore, be it

11 Sec. 1. Franklin County; taxes apportioned. 12 Resolved: That the following sum is granted as a tax 13 on Franklin County to be apportioned, assessed, 14 collected and applied to the purposes of paying debts 15 and necessary expenses of the county as authorized 16 herein, and for other purposes of law, for the 17 calendar year 1988:
