IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

AN ACT to Make the Exemption for Home Knitters from the Unemployment Insurance Tax Retroactive.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 follows:

7 Home-knitter exemption; abatement. tax Any 8 unpaid contribution required to be paid to the Unemployment Compensation Fund, or any interest 9 or 10 penalty assessed on those unpaid contributions under

the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 26, chapter 13, due to a person performing services as a home knitter under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 26, section 1043, subsection 11, paragraph F, subparagraph (35), for any period of employment prior to January 1, 1986, is abated and no longer due to be paid.

STATEMENT OF FACT

8 The purpose of this bill is to forgive delinquent 9 contributions to the Unemployment Compensation Fund 10 which are due from home knitters for any period prior 11 to January 1, 1986.
