 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18	This bill provides funding to municipal school districts for the inspection and replacement of unsafe pre-1980 school buses. The department will develop a safety rating that address seat height, seat back padding, chassis, frame and roof strength, as well as the normal inspection procedure. Rating information will be forwarded by the school to the department which will maintain a priority list of unsafe buses based on this data. A formula will be developed that	1 1 1

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combines the school funding formula plus bus rating to equal the percentage of reimbursement. The more unsafe the bus the higher the rating and the greater the incentive for schools to replace them.
