STATEMENT OF FACT

8 Central mid-coast Maine is facing a crisis in 9 traffic congestion along United States Route 1 from 10 Bath to Lincolnville. With a decrease in available 11 federal funds it becomes increasingly important to 12 study the methods of financing a bypass. This resolve 13 provides for an 18-month study of general issues 14 facing creation of a bypass and funding options 15 available.

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
