COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1837, L.D. 2514,
Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Charter of the Brunswick
Sewer District."

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 5. Referendum; effective date. Section 2
of this Act shall be submitted to the legal voters of
the Brunswick Sewer District on or before April 15,
1990. The election shall be called by the town
officers and shall be held at the regular voting
places. The election shall be called, advertised and
conducted according to the law relating to municipal
elections. The town clerk shall reduce the subject
matter of section 2 of this Act to the following
question:

"Shall the debt limit of the Brunswick Sewer
District be increased to \$20,000,000?"

Section 2 of this Act shall take effect
immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the
legal voters of the Brunswick Sewer District voting at
the election. Failure of approval shall not prevent
subsequent elections.

The results of the election shall be declared by
the town officers and due certificates of the election
