23	STATEMENT OF FACT
24	The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the
25	definition of "owner-built" housing for the purposes
26 20	of an exemption from the energy efficiency standards. It is the intent of the Legislature that any person

that person's own residence or who directly hires a general contractor to serve the same function is exempt from the standards. This exemption is premised on the sound assumption that these exempted parties have sufficient motivation from the free market to install good energy efficient homes because they will directly realize the long-term cost savings.
