SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1856, L.D. 2541,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Reporting Requirements under
9 the Campaign Finance Laws."

Amend the bill in section 1, in paragraph A by
11 striking out the first underlined sentence (page 2,
12 lines 1 to 3 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in section 3 by striking
14 out all of paragraph A and inserting in its place the
15 following:


'A. The value of a contribution sold at public
17 auction is the actual value, appraised value or
18 the actual price paid at the auction. Items
19 purchased at a public auction by any individual
20 shall not be considered political donations under
21 campaign contribution limitations.'

SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1856, L.D. 2541

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment removes duplicative language and
3 clarifies that the value of a campaign contribution
4 which is sold at an auction can be calculated based on
5 the actual value, the appraised value or the actual
6 price paid at the auction.
