7 HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 959, L.D. 2544, Bill,
8 "AN ACT to Change the Definition of Wine Coolers."

9 Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of
10 the first line after the enacting clause (page 2, line
11 16 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

12 Further amend the bill in subsection 1, in
13 paragraph A, by striking out all of subparagraph (1)
14 and inserting in its place the following:

15 '(1) Plain, sparkling or carbonated water;
16 and'

17 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end
18 before the emergency clause the following:

19 'Sec. 2. Report. The Bureau of Public Services
20 shall submit a report and any necessary implementing
21 legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on
22 Business Legislation of the First Regular Session of
23 the 114th Legislature on January 15, 1989, concerning
24 the effectiveness of the definition of "wine cooler"
25 contained in section 1 of this Act and its
26 implementation.'

The purpose of this amendment is to simplify the definition of wine cooler by deleting the reference to the 3% requirement of water. The amendment also requires the Bureau of Public Services to report back to the Joint Standing Committee on Business Legislation on January 15, 1989, regarding the effectiveness of the definition of wine cooler and its implementation.
