Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund to the AIDS Lodging House, Inc., the sum of \$35,000 for the fiscal year 1988-89 for the purpose of maintaining and administering the AIDS Lodging House in the Portland area for persons with AIDS or AIDS-related conditions, and for one professional staff member to manage the

STATEMENT OF FACT

3 The purpose of this resolve is to appropriate money from the General Fund to the AIDS Lodging House, Inc., to provide lodging for AIDS patients who are 5 6 well enough to be discharged from a hospital, but are in need of affordable housing and a supportive community. The objectives of the facility are to 7 8 9 provide 1,095 service days to AIDS victims for one 10 year and to provide supportive counseling, information 11 and referral services and health monitoring 12 residents of the lodging house. It is estimated that 13 approximately 20% of all persons with AIDS in this 14 State will require this intermediate care.
