RESOLVE, to Establish a Training Program on the Subject of Radiation Safety for the Employees of the Department of Educational and Cultural Services.

Educational Training Program. Resolved: That the Department of Human Services, Bureau of Health in conjunction with the Maine Emergency Management Agency establish a training program on the health effects and

10 The presence of radioactive materials in 11 Department of Educational and Cultural Services causing undue stress to certain employees in 12 13 building. An independent study has shown that the 14 cancer incidence of building occupants does not exceed 15 the number expected when compared to the national 16 cancer incidence rates. The same study concluded that 17 there is no connection between the reported cancer cases and the work conditions in the Department of Educational and Cultural Services building. Testing 18 19 20 has demonstrated that the levels of radiation 21 throughout the office areas and basement storage area do not exceed those of background radiation levels 22 23 found throughout Maine.

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
