## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Sale of Certain Public Lands Located in the City of Bangor.

Whereas, the Commissioner of Administration has determined that certain state-owned land located in the City of Bangor is surplus to the current and

Whereas, the Legislature finds it to be in the best interest of the State that this land be offered

expected future needs of the State; and

1 for sale in order that it may be available for 2 utilization by, or for the benefit of, citizens of the 3 State; now, therefore, be it

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Sale of real estate authorized. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Administration, through the Bureau of Public Improvements, is authorized to convey by sale the interest of the State in real estate located in the City of Bangor in accordance with the following.

9 1. The State's conveyance of interest, 10 authorized by this resolve, shall be in the form of a quit-claim deed for land, together with any buildings on the land, located in the City of Bangor, consisting 11 12 13 of 25 acres more or less as follows: Beginning at the 14 State Street entrance road to Bangor Mental Health Institute then running in an easterly direction along 15 16 State Street to its junction with the Hogan Road, then 17 in a northerly direction along the Hogan Road to the institute's Hogan Road entrance, then along entrance road onto the institute's grounds 300 18 300 feet 19 20 more or less, then following the contour of the hill below the hospital to a point in the State Street entrance road 100 feet below the driveway entrance to 21 22 23 the halfway house, then to the junction of the State 24 Street entrance road and State Street to the point of 25 beginning.

- 26 The Commissioner of Administration, through 27 the Bureau of Public Improvements, shall advertise the property for sale to the highest bidder, except that the State reserves the right to reject any or all bids 28 29 30 should the commissioner determine, on the basis of a 31 market value appraisal of the property, that responsive bid has not resulted from the process. 32
- 33 3. Net proceeds to the State resulting from 34 successful consummation of the sale will be deposited 35 as undedicated revenue to the General Fund.

## 36 STATEMENT OF FACT

37 This resolve authorizes the Commissioner of 38 Administration, through the Bureau of Public

After conducting an appropriate legal title search and obtaining a market value appraisal, the commissioner will advertise the property for sale to the highest bidder, while retaining the right to reject any or all bids in the event that, in the commissioner's judgment, they are unresponsive.

Net proceeds from the sale will be deposited as undedicated General Fund revenue of the State.

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
