STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Sale of Certain Public Lands Located in the City of Augusta.

Whereas, the Commissioner of Administration has determined that certain state-owned land in the City of Augusta is surplus to the current and expected future needs of the State; and

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Whereas, the Legislature finds it to be in the

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1 best interest of the State that this land be offered 2 for sale in order that it may be available for 3 utilization by, or for the benefit of, citizens of the 4 State; now, therefore, be it

5 Sale of real estate authorized. Resolved: That 6 the Commissioner of Administration, through the Bureau Public Improvements, is authorized to convey 7 of bv 8 sale the interest of the State in real estate located 9 in the City of Augusta in accordance with the 10 following:

11 1. The State's conveyance of interest, as authorized by this resolve, shall be in the form of a quit claim deed for land located in the City of Augusta, as identified on Tax Map #10, Section 32 and 12 13 14 15 consisting of 4.13+ acres as follows: Beginning at a point at the corner of Hospital Street and Piggery Road, then running northerly along Hospital Street for 400 feet more or less to the corner of the property 16 17 18 19 formerly owned by Francis Barrett, then running easterly along the property line for 400 feet more or less, then southerly for 400 feet more or less to the 20 21 22 Piggery Road and from that juncture 400 feet more or 23 less to the beginning point.

24 The Commissioner of Administration, 2. through 25 Bureau of Public Improvements, shall advertise the 26 said property for sale to the highest bidder, except that the State reserves the right to reject any or all 27 28 bids should the commissioner determine, on the basis 29 of a market value appraisal of the property, that a 30 responsive bid has not resulted from the process.

31 3. Net proceeds to the State resulting from 32 successful consummation of the sale will be deposited 33 as undedicated revenue to the General Fund.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve authorizes the Commissioner of Administration, through the Bureau of Public Improvements, to undertake, on behalf of the State,

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the sale of property located in the City of Augusta, for which neither the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation, to which the property is currently entrusted, nor any other state agency has any current or anticipated need.

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After conducting an appropriate legal title search and obtaining a market value appraisal, the commissioner shall advertise the property for sale to the highest bidder, while retaining the right to reject any or all bids if, in the commissioner's judgment, they are unresponsive.

12 Net proceeds from the sale will be deposited as 13 undedicated General Fund revenue of the State.

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
