7 The Legislature further finds that management programs 8 should be designed to meet local circumstances appropriate, but also finds that a minimum size limit to be beneficial must be a uniform standard statewide. 9 10

11 The Legislature intends by this Article article enhance the value of the State's shellfish resource by 12 institution of uniform standards which 13 implemented and enforced statewide. 14

15 Minimum size. It is unlawful to possess 16 soft-shelled clam shell stock whose shells are less 17 than 2 1 1/2 inches in the largest diameter.

18 Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6681, sub-§§4 and 7, 19 enacted by PL 1983, c. 838, §6, are repealed.

20 STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill is the minority recommendation of the 22 Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources pursuant to its review of the 2-inch clam law. The bill 23 changes the minimum allowable size of soft-shell clam stock from 2 inches to 1 1/2 inches and repeals the 24 25 26 tolerance factor.
