SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1904, L.D. 2601,

Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of

11

the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line

12

6 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

13

Further amend the bill in that part designated

14

"§13075." in subsection 3 in paragraph B in the first

15

line (page 3, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the

16

following: "A 10-year" and inserting in its place the

17

following: 'A capital investment'

18

Further amend the bill in that part designated

19

"§13075." in subsection 4 by striking out all of

20

paragraph A and inserting in its place the following:

21

'A. The department shall establish a preference

22

for those municipalities which demonstrate a

23

strong commitment and effort to the development

and improvement of infrastructure.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end

26

before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds

are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out

the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

14

This amendment clarifies 2 provisions concerning eligibility for economic growth corridor grants. The provision concerning a 10-year capital investment has been replaced with a requirement that a municipality have a capital investment plan included in its comprehensive plan. Municipalities which have demonstrated a commitment and effort to the development and improvement of infrastructure will be one of the categories for which priorities for grants due are to be considered.


