This new draft reenacts the

23 Statutes, section 7061, subsection 3, which was repealed effective March 15, 1988. Section 2 of the 24 new draft authorizes the continuation of collective bargaining on the issue of standards for the 25 26 27 preparation and updating of written job classification 28 specifications.
