1 2 3	AN ACT Concerning the Regulation of Welders.		
4 5	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:		
6 7	Sec. 1. Commission created and charged. The Commission to Study the Regulation of Welders is		

8 established. The commission shall:

1. Determine which agency of State Government
2 issues certification of welder qualification;

3 2. Determine the method by which qualifications 4 of welders are determined;

5 3. Recommend the location of testing facilities, 6 method to qualify testing personnel and facilities, 7 and audit of testing personnel and facilities;

8 4. Review the areas of welding activity which 9 should be regulated; and

10 5. Determine the cost of the recommended program 11 and method of funding, including fee structure.

12 Sec. 2. Appointment. The commission shall 13 consist of 11 members, appointed in the following 14 manner: one Senator, appointed by the President of the Senate; one Representative, appointed by the Speaker 15 16 of the House; and 9 members appointed by the Governor, including a representative of a structural fabrication 17 company, a representative of a boiler and pressure 18 19 vessel repair company, a welder representing the 20 American Federation of Labor, a plant engineer, a 21 welding department instructor from а 22 vocational-technical institute, a boiler inspector 23 from an insurance company, a representative from the 24 Board of Boiler Rules, a representative of the 25 Department of Transportation and a representative of 26 the Boiler, Elevator and Tramway Division in the 27 Department of Labor.

28 Sec. 3. Convening of commission. When the 29 appointment of all commission members is completed, 30 the Governor or the Governor's designee shall call the 31 first meeting.

32 The commission shall Sec. 4. Report. present 33 its findings, together with any recommended legislation, to the joint standing committee of the 34 35 jurisdiction business Legislature having over 36 legislation at the First Regular Session of the 114th 37 Legislature by January 31, 1989.

Sec. 5. Assistance. Department of The Labor shall provide staff assistance to the commission.

Sec. 6. Compensation. The members of the 4 commission who are Legislators shall receive the legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised 2, for Statutes, Title 3, section each day's attendance at commission meetings. All members of the 8 commission shall receive reimbursement for expenses 9 upon application to the Commissioner of Labor.

10 Sec. 7. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the 11 12 purposes of this Act.
