HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1911, L.D. 2608,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Establish an Enhanced 9-1-1 System."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the preamble.

Further amend the bill by striking out all of  
sections 5 to 15 and inserting in their place the  
following:

'Sec. 5. Transition. Sections 1 to 4 of this  
Act shall not become effective unless and until 2/3 of  
both houses of the Legislature deem it necessary in  
accordance with the Constitution of Maine, Article IX,  
Section 14, to authorize the issuance of bonds on  
behalf of the State to provide funds for the  
establishment of an enhanced 9-1-1 system and the  
issuance of the bonds has been ratified by a majority  
of the electors voting at a general or special  
election.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

2           The purpose of this amendment is to amend the  
3 original bill so as to remove the provisions for a  
4 bond issuance to be ratified by the voters at the next  
5 general election in November. The amendment preserves  
6 the substantive provisions of the bill in the law, but  
7 delays their effectiveness until after the  
8 ratification of a bond issuance at some time in the  
9 future.
