Amend the bill in section 7 in the first paragraph in the first and 2nd lines (page 5, lines 32 and 33 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "A Subcommittee on Rehabilitation shall be established" and inserting in its place the following: 'The Legislative Council shall establish a Subcommittee on Rehabilitation'

16 Further amend the bill in section 7 in the 4th 17 paragraph in the first line (page 6, line 20 in L.D.) 18 by striking out the following: "5 public" and 19 inserting in its place the following: '3 public'

20 Further amend the bill in section 7 in the last 21 paragraph in the last line (page 7, line 24 in L.D.) 22 by striking out the following: "March 15" and 23 inserting in its place the following: 'December 1'

24 Further amend the bill by striking out all of 25 section 8 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 8. Appropriation. The following funds are
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
purposes of this Act.
