Notwithstanding the first paragraph, the tandem axle unit limit for 5 or more axle combination vehicles shall not exceed 44,000 pounds and a 6-axle combination vehicle, as defined in section 1652, subsection 1, paragraph E, may be operated, or caused to be operated, with a maximum gross weight of  $\frac{1}{2}007000$  pounds, provided that the maximum gross weight permitted on a tandem axle unit shall be 44,000 pounds and the maximum gross weight permitted on a tri-axle unit shall be 54,000 pounds, and provided that the distance between the extreme axles, excluding the steering axle, is at least 32 feet.
