STATEMENT OF FACT

This is the regular yearly resolve for the laying of taxes in York County. It also contains a provision that all funds accruing to the county under the provisions of the Jail Operations Surcharge Fund and the County Jail Reimbursement Program are to be placed in a dedicated account to be utilized for the refurbishing of the old county jail for use as a short duration detention center for those in a prerelease or half way house status.

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
