HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1929, L.D. 2629,
Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the Annexation of Cove
Point Township by the Town of Greenville."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Referendum; effective date. This Act
shall take effect 90 days after adjournment of the
Legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its
submission to the legal voters in the Town of
Greenville and Cove Point Township in Piscataquis
County at separate elections called and held in the
town and the township at the time of the next
statewide elections. Such elections shall be called,
held and conducted in the same manner as local option
elections under Title 28-A, chapter 5, except that no
petitions for the elections may be required.

The subject matter of this Act shall be presented
at each election in the form of the following question:

"Shall the Town of Greenville annex a portion of
Cove Point Township in Piscataquis County?"

This Act shall be considered approved for both the
town and township upon its acceptance by a majority of
the legal voters of the town voting in its election
and a majority of the legal voters of the township
voting in its election, provided that the total number
of votes cast for and against the acceptance of this

1 Act at each election equals or exceeds 50% of the
2 total votes cast for all candidates for Governor in
3 the 2 entities at the last gubernatorial election. If
4 there are no legal voters in Cove Point Township at
5 the time of the next statewide election, the Act shall
6 be considered approved upon its acceptance by a
7 majority of the legal voters of the town, if
8 sufficient votes have been cast.

9 The result of the vote shall be declared by the
10 Secretary of State and certificate thereof filed by
11 him in his office.'

12 STATEMENT OF FACT

13 This amendment requires a new referendum in each
14 of the entities involved. For the annexation to pass,
15 the total number of votes cast must be equal to at
16 least 50% of those cast at the last gubernatorial
17 election and annexation must be approved by a majority
18 of those voting in each of the 2 entities.
