HOUSE AMENDMENT " *D* " to H.P. 1930, L.D. 2630,
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Motor Vehicle Laws and to
Allocate Funds to the Division of Motor Vehicles."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title
and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Amend the Motor Vehicle Laws.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the
3rd paragraph after the title (page 2, lines 3 to 6 in
L.D.)

Further amend the bill by striking out sections 5
to 13.

Further amend the bill by striking out sections 25
and 26.

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the
emergency clause and inserting in its place the
following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when
approved.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of the
fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 1930, L.D. 2630

1 'FISCAL NOTE

2 If enacted, this amendment would eliminate
3 \$1,700,000 of new Highway Fund revenue. The Highway
4 Fund budget as proposed by the Conference Committee
5 Report for L.D. 2463 makes use of these funds. This
6 amendment also deletes the allocation of funds in this
7 bill for a building for the Division of Motor
8 Vehicles.'

9 STATEMENT OF FACT

10 The amendment deletes any increase in motor
11 vehicle registration fees and deletes the allocation
12 of those funds for a building for the Division of
13 Motor Vehicles.
