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Sec. 1. To raise money for construction of a new jail and law enforcement facility for Knox County.

The county commissioners of Knox County are authorized to raise and expend a sum not to exceed \$4,900,000 for construction of a new jail and law enforcement

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facility to be located in Rockland.

- Sec. 2. Aid from other sources. The county commissioners of Knox County are authorized to borrow any portion of the sums authorized in this Act from or through any agency or department of the State and of the Federal Government. The county commissioners are authorized to receive grants of money and other assistance from or through any agency or department for any of the purposes authorized in this Act.
- todá szárezésőt igele Sec. 3. Bonds. To provide funds for the county jail facilities, the Treasurer of Knox County, with the approval of the county commissioners, may borrow from time to time upon the full faith and credit of the county such sums, not exceeding in the aggregate \$8,900,000, as may be necessary and may insure bonds therefor which shall bear on their face the words "Knox County Capital Improvement Bonds Act of 1988." Each authorized issue shall be payable in such annual installments, beginning not more than 2 years from the date thereof and not earlier than the year 1989, as will extinguish each loan in not more than 20 years from its date. The bonds shall be signed by the treasurer of the county and countersigned by majority of the county commissioners. The county may sell the securities at public or private sale upon such terms and conditions as the county commissioners may deem proper, but at not less than par and accrued
- Temporary notes. The county treasurer, .29 Sec. 4. with the approval of the county commissioners, 30 issue temporary notes of the county, payable in not 31 more than one year from their dates, in anticipation 32 of the issue of serial bonds under this Act and may 33 renew the same, but the time within which the serial bonds shall become due and payable shall not, by 35 36 reason of the temporary notes, be extended beyond the 37 fixed by this Act. Any notes issued anticipation of the serial bonds shall be paid from 38 39 the proceeds of the bonds.
- 40 Sec. 5. Bonds authorized but not issued. Any bonds authorized but not issued, or for which bond anticipation notes have not been issued within 5 years of the ratification of this Act, shall be deauthorized

- and may not be issued, provided that the Legislature may, within 2 years after the expiration of that 5-year period, extend the period for issuing any remaining unissued bonds or bond anticipation notes for an additional amount of time not to exceed 5 years.
- 6 Sec. 6. Referendum for ratification. This shall be submitted to the legal voters of Knox County. The date of the submission shall be 7 8 determined by the Knox County Board of Commissioners 9 but not later than 18 months after adjournment of the 10 Legislature. Prior to establishing the referendum 11 date, the Knox County Board of Commissioners 12 select the site for the new facility within the City 13 of Rockland. The commissioners shall consult with the Knox County legislative delegation before the final 14 15
- The county commissioners shall cause the preparation of the required ballots on which they shall state the subject matter of this Act in the following question:

- "Shall the issuance of bonds be authorized in an amount not to exceed \$4,900,000 for the construction of a new jail and law enforcement facility in Rockland for Knox County?"
- The ballot shall also contain the following information, to be determined by the county commissioners, which is to be accurate as of the date when it is necessary to begin preparation of the ballot questions:
- 30 l. A statement as to the total debt service of 31 the requested issue divided into principal and 32 interest and indicating the interest rate and period 33 of the bond; and
- 34 2. A statement as to the county's bonded 35 indebtedness prior to the requested bond issue.
- The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same.
- 39 This Act shall take effect for all the purposes

1 hereof after the Knox County commissioners have declared and certified the results of the election, provided that the date of certification is not less than 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature. In order to be effective, the Act must be accepted by the legal voters voting at the election; provided that the . 7 total number of votes cast for and against the acceptance of this Act equals or exceeds 30% of the total votes for all candidates for Governor cast in the next previous gubernatorial election in the county. If at any such first election, the total number of votes cast for or against acceptance of this less than 30% of the total votes for all -9 10 11 12 13 candidates for Governor cast in the county in the next 14 15 previous gubernatorial election, the county commissioners may submit the question to voters not more than one other time within the time prescribed in 16 17 this section.

The result of such elections shall be declared by the Knox County commissioners and due certificate filed with the Secretary of State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Knox

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County commissioners to seek approval from county voters to raise up to \$4,900,000 for construction of a new jail and law enforcement facility for Knox County. The county will supplement these funds with state funds that will be appropriated under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 34-A, section 1210.

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
