SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1939, L.D. 2638,
Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Additional Errors and
Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the bill by adding after section 9 a new
section to read:

'Sec. 10. 12 MRSA §6671, sub-§2, as amended by
PL 1983, c. 838, §2, is further amended to read:

2. Municipal program and ordinance. Any
municipality may, by vote of its legislative body,
adopt, amend or repeal a shellfish conservation
ordinance regulating the possession of shellfish in
any area of the municipality as provided by this
section. A shellfish conservation ordinance enacted
under this section may provide for methods different
than the methods provided in subsection 3 for
selecting the nonresidents to be awarded commercial
shellfish licenses and for notifying the previous
year's nonresident license holders of the number of
licenses and the procedure for applying for licenses
in the current year.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections
to read consecutively.


