	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
6 7	36 MRSA \$1760, sub-\$48, as repealed and replaced by PL 1987, c. 522, \$1, is amended to read:
8	48. Scheduled airlines. The sale or lease of an

This subsection is repeated on October 1, 1989. This subsection shall take effect retroactively beginning on January 1, 1984, and shall remain in effect until October 1, 1989.
10	STATEMENT OF FACT
	This bill makes retroactive the effective date of a sales tax exemption for the sale or lease of aircraft, or repair or replacement parts for certain aircraft.
