AN ACT to Change the Effective Date for HIV Counseling.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows:

6 Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §19203-A, sub-§2, as amended by 7 PL 1987, c. 811, §4, is further amended to read:

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2. Insurers. Persons required to take an HIV

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1 test by an insurer, nonprofit hospital or medical 2 service organization or nonprofit health care plan 3 must provide their written informed consent on forms 4 approved by the Superintendent of Insurance. 5 Pretest and post-test counseling must be provided by 6 the person or organization requesting the test. The 7 Superintendent of Insurance may promulgate rules to 8 define language requirements of the form.

STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill delays the effective date of the 19 counseling requirements for persons who obtain an HIV 20 test as part of an application for insurance. The 21 delay allows insurers the time necessary to develop 22 administrative procedures for counseling.

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
