AN ACT to Return Certain Positions within the Department of Environmental Protection to Classified Service Under the Civil Service Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §938, sub-§1, ¶¶F and G, as amended by PL 1987, c. 816, Pt. KK, §8, are further amended to read:

7 8 9 10 11 12	This bill repeals the provision which declassifies 6 division director positions in the Department of Environmental Protection. The repealed section made these positions subject to political appointment This bill returns those positions into the classified service subject to appointment under the Civil Service Law.
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
