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1           **AN ACT to Return Certain Positions within the**  
2           **Department of Environmental Protection to Classified**  
3           **Service Under the Civil Service Law.**  
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5           Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
6           follows:

7           **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §938, sub-§1, ¶¶F and G, as**  
8           **amended by PL 1987, c. 816, Pt. KK, §8, are further**  
9           **amended to read:**

1 F. Director, Bureau of Water Quality Control; and

2 G. Director, Bureau of Oil and Hazardous  
3 Materials Control.

4 Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §938, sub-§1, ¶¶H to M, as  
5 enacted by PL 1987, c. 816, Pt. KK, §9, are repealed.

6 STATEMENT OF FACT

7 This bill repeals the provision which declassifies  
8 6 division director positions in the Department of  
9 Environmental Protection. The repealed section made  
10 these positions subject to political appointment.  
11 This bill returns those positions into the classified  
12 service subject to appointment under the Civil Service  
13 Law.

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
