STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-EIGHT

AN ACT Concerning Relocation of the Maine Emergency Management Agency Radiological Calibration Facility.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 follows:

7 Sec. 1. Radiation Calibration Facility 8 Relocation Committee; establishment. There is hereby 9 created the Radiation Calibration Facility Relocation

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Committee. The committee members are: The Director 1 2 of the Maine Emergency Management Agency, who shall serve as chairman, the Director of Public Improvements 3 Δ and the Director of the Division of Health Engineering, Bureau of Health. The committee shall 5 6 function until December 31, 1989.

7 The duties of the committee Sec. 2. Duties. 8 include: Locating a proposed new site and facility to house the Maine Emergency Management Agency radiological calibration facility; determining the 9 10 estimated cost to relocate the facility; 11 determinina the Nuclear Regulatory Commission requirements for moving the facility; determining a timetable for relocating the facility; and determining any state 12 13 14 15 actions required, including a recommendation for 16 funding the proposed relocation of the facility.

17 Sec. 3. Report. The chairman shall present a 18 report of the committee findings, together with any 19 necessary implementing legislation, to the First 20 Regular Session of the 114th Legislature on April 3, 21 1989.

STATEMENT OF FACT

23 The purpose of this bill is to assess the process necessary to move the radiological calibration 24 facility from the basement of the Education Building to a new location. A new site needs to be located for 25 26 27 the facility. A new facility may need to be The Nuclear Regulatory Commission 28 constructed. licenses such facilities and must approve the move and 29 30 the proposed facility. Costs will be incurred and a 31 funding source must be determined.

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
